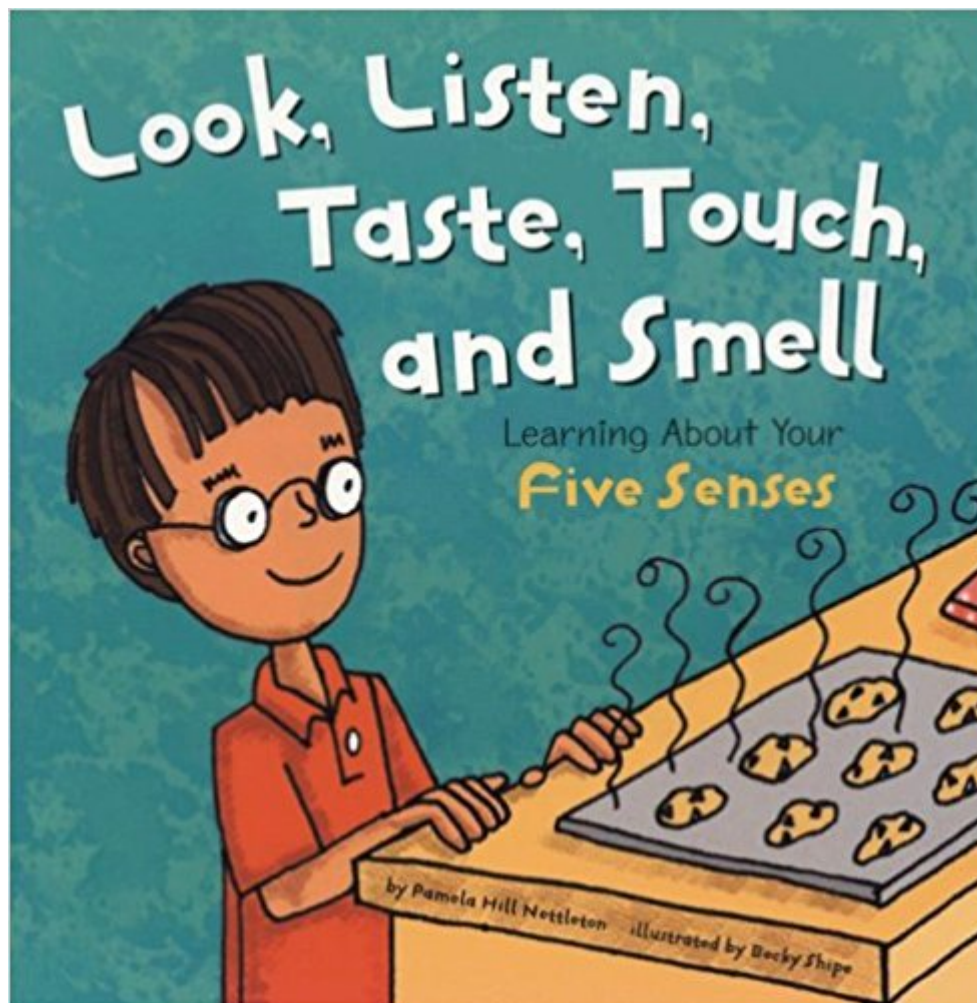

Very informative. I bought it however for my preschool class and it is definitely more advanced than that age level. I'd recommend this more for 1-2 grade level students.
