

The book lends itself well to reading it either all at once or by the chapter of your choosing. It is written in a conversational style and it is like the author is speaking with you. I really liked that. Upon its arrival, I paged through the book. My jaw dropped when I saw a picture of an ornament that was like one my family has that was on my Uncle William's first Christmas tree (it is over 100 years old). It is very simple, but it is

part of our family history. Our tradition is that it is the first ornament on the tree and the last one taken off when the tree is taken down. Then I saw a picture of an ornament that was on my brother's first Christmas tree. There are pictures of all kinds of vintage Christmas decorations: Christmas albums, cards, lights, sheet music, etc., each one providing a visit back in time not only from my experience, but remembering stories Mom and Dad told me about Christmases when they were young. A big smile was on my face with each turn of a page, wondering what I would see next. It reminded me of child-like Christmas anticipation! Then, my brother and I paged through the book together. We were saying, "I remember that!" and "Remember when?" And even, "Hey what about?" It was a fun evening of nostalgia that I know will be repeated. I love to decorate for Christmas. And as each decoration (some in their original boxes) is carefully unpacked, I recall Christmases past as the memories associated with each of them come to mind. As I mentioned above, reading *A Very Vintage Christmas* brought back those memories for me too. "De-decorating" (when the decorations are lovingly packed away) is not something I look forward to because the house looks so stark for a few days after. But now I don't have to wait for Christmas to look at decorations, because this book will not be packed away for the season. It will have a spot on my bookshelf throughout the year, right next to my copy of *Little Women* that Mom gave me for Christmas when I was a little girl. I just know that decorating this holiday season will be even more joyous having read this book! Ask Santa to bring you *A Very Vintage Christmas* this year. Better yet, why not buy it yourself and have it on the table next to Santa's cookies and milk so he can enjoy it too!
