

Synopsis

Few women have gone to war more defiantly and courageously than Scotswoman Ellen Sinclair. It has been some time since I read this and I have forgotten a lot of it, but I do remember that I really liked the semi-fictionalized character of Ellen Sinclair and her heroic, pragmatic, and yes, romantic personality. I remember thinking that she represented honor in a time where women were not thought to have that quality. As all of Rosalind Lakes books are, it is well written and tight in character portrayal with great atmosphere. Ms. Laker's version of what she thinks happened to this "wife of a Scottish chieftain" is completely plausible.
