

This is a very powerful book. Charles Swindoll tells the entire story of David, the king of Israel in the Bible. David was known as the man of God but he was also a sinner. The author shows how we can learn today about David's mistakes to help us when we are in trouble. By using these lessons you can't help but improve your walk with God and grow closer to Him.

It's likely most people would think of David as the boy who killed Goliath, or his affair with Bathsheba. There is so much more to this man: leadership, innovative military tactics, an over-achiever, intensely loyal, the significant consequences of his affair... and so much more. Understanding the context of David's life provides an eye-opening gateway to understanding the Psalms he wrote, political impact that continues to this day. A great book to read, and a great gift.

Excellent book. There are a few times when I felt that Charles Swindoll was interjecting a bit too much of his own, extra-Biblical beliefs into the life of David, but it was still an excellent work. In the chapter on Forgiveness, Chapter 21, the author states that David forgave Shimei, yet in 1 Kings 2:8-9. David charges Solomon to kill Shimei. I don't believe David forgave Shimei, he simply chose not to kill him because of his sorrow over the death of Absalom.

Very good point of view of how to view sin and how to live up to the potential that God has placed in you.
