Chezar shares her passion for flowers and has put together an inspiring volume. She frequently refers to her style as painterly, and the description fits perfectly. The book includes tips and tricks such as using the concepts of chiaroscuro and ombre to create depth and movement. There are sections that cover essential techniques, tools, and a very helpful seasonal flower guide. In addition, there are recipes that list the precise flowers needed to replicate a particular arrangement along with detailed written instructions and stunning photographs. The recipes cover a wide range of floral arrangement styles and they will inspire you to create beautiful arrangements at home. I received a copy of the book for review purposes.

While it has some helpful information on the subject, the real benefit was the cost saving tips and alternative sources for flowers and foliage.
