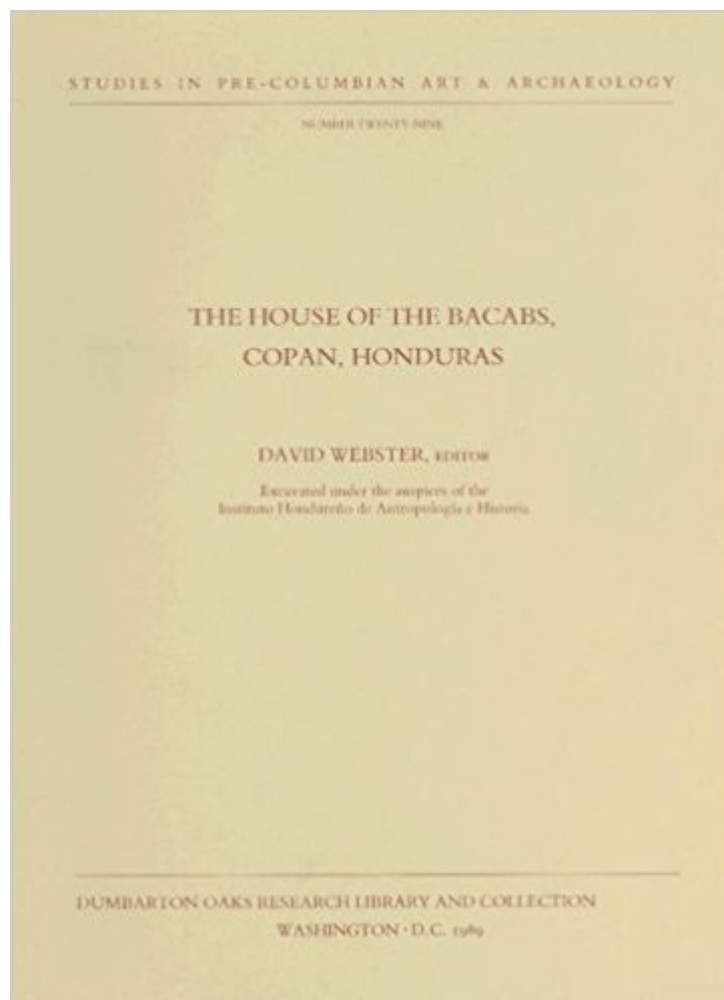

The [monograph's] combination of traditional archaeological techniques and epigraphic-iconographic investigation represents the future of Maya studies. There is very little information in the literature that presents such a convincing argument concerning the function of architectural compounds.

David Kenyon Webster worked as a reporter and writer after the war. "The Saturday Evening Post" published a portion of his memoir, but book publishers rejected his manuscript, seeking sensationalized novels of the war rather than authentic memoirs.
