The information on how the market has changed over the past few years is quite useful. The grading scale is very handy. I figured worn coins were typically not worth much, but I didn't realize there was so much variation in coins never issued (due to damage from being in the bag).This would be very useful to a collector in the field, or someone who just wants an idea of what a collection they inherited might be worth.The companion

does a great job of providing contact information for various societies that could be joined, also.

There are many items in these books that are often botched in a Kindle conversion, but all four of these books are done well. There are two very similar books here --Â CompanionÂ andÂ Field Guide. Both of them have moderate collecting info, and prices for a wide variety of US Coins. I haven't seen a huge amount of difference in the info available in these two free books, so I'm not yet sure which to point out as the better book.
