

She has put herself in danger, traveled the world, and discovered many secrets that have saved lives. Simon is St. Simon's Vicar. He has led a quiet life, relying on the town's people to provide the bare minimum for him to survive. The church is falling apart, the parish is shrinking, and is truly in financial ruin. I was fascinated by the speed-healing phenomenon, unless it was supposed to be a miracle connected to St. Simon's toe. In any event, a broken arm was completely healed in just a few days.10

Oh how I loved this story. Sahara Kelly always does a good Regency and this one does not disappoint at all. Simon needed this story. It was his all along, and so was she.
