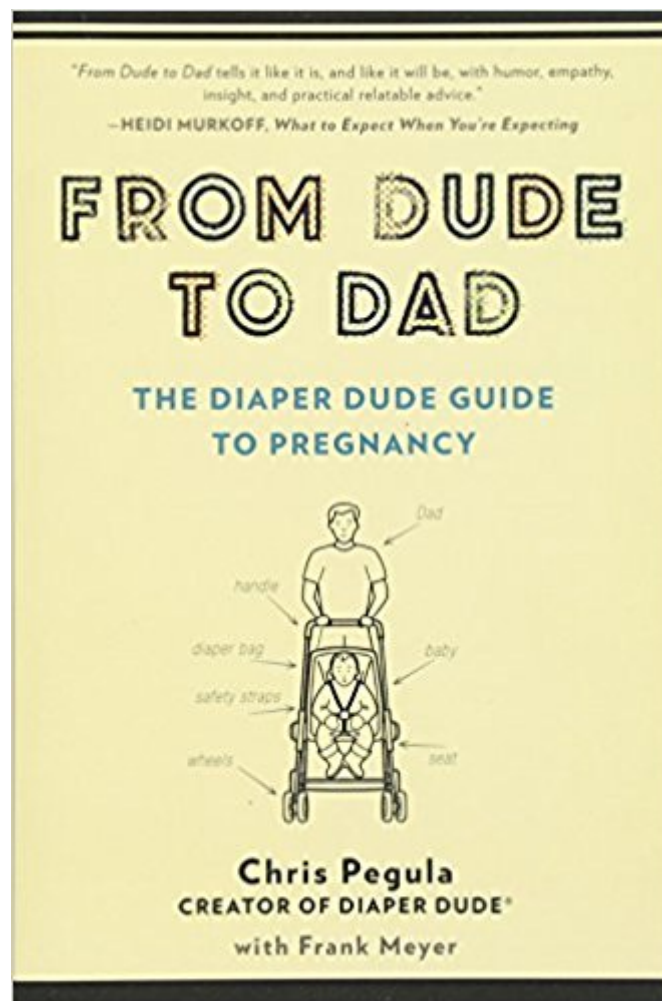

I don't know, maybe the current crop of fathers to be needs this type of hand holding, but I'm guessing not. It's good for a chuckle, I guess. If you need a good book, get *The Expectant Father* by Armin Brott.

I bought this book for my husband and we both ended up reading it. I'm a first time mom and my husband was FREAKING OUT when he found out we were going to have a baby. This book really helped him get past the initial meltdown and see the joys that come with being a father (and even the potential business opportunities - he loved that part!).
