There is something about this book that is quite special. And at the same time, it's hard to know if it's a fictional book or a true life journey. Megre doesn't write very well, but what is written has depth. And some of what he writes, I have never seen written before. Therefore, it's worth reading. This may not seem like a good review of this book, mostly because the things that we as a society say are important about a book, like great story, well written, etc., this book doesn't have. But it has something else. And you can only know by reading it. It inspired me in surprising ways.

A religious book of sorts. I'm an atheist so what kept me reading was that it is by a Russian writer and takes place on the taiga in Russia. I guess it's supposed to be true but I think it makes a good story. Very unusual, especially for a male writer. The writer is telling the story about meeting this very unusual free-spirited female living without a house or any possessions except a very few clothes. The taiga is the world's largest forest both coniferous and boreal. It is very cold there with lots of snow. How does she survive there? Anastasia has magically summoned the author to her and is priming him to write this book, which will change the people in the world, as best I can describe it, to free-spirited open air-people like her. The earth and its peoples will go back to living in harmony. Something like that. Hard to explain briefly. She seems to me to be sort of a female Jesus Christ.....as if we need another such fantasy. I enjoyed it. It is a series and I may buy the next one.

This book and the many books that follow in the series are simply amazing and captivating. There were many times I was incredulous about certain ideas, situations or actions but I kept reading and

didn't let it distract me from further plowing through all these great books. Many of the incredulous aspects became understandable later on from reading further and from contemplation on my own.

A great way to get into the whole Ringing Cedars idea. Anastasia could be a life changer, as it has been for me. The whole concept of a Vedic recluse living completely connected to the universal mind, even protected and enhanced by it, is just a supper mind tingling event, at least for me.
