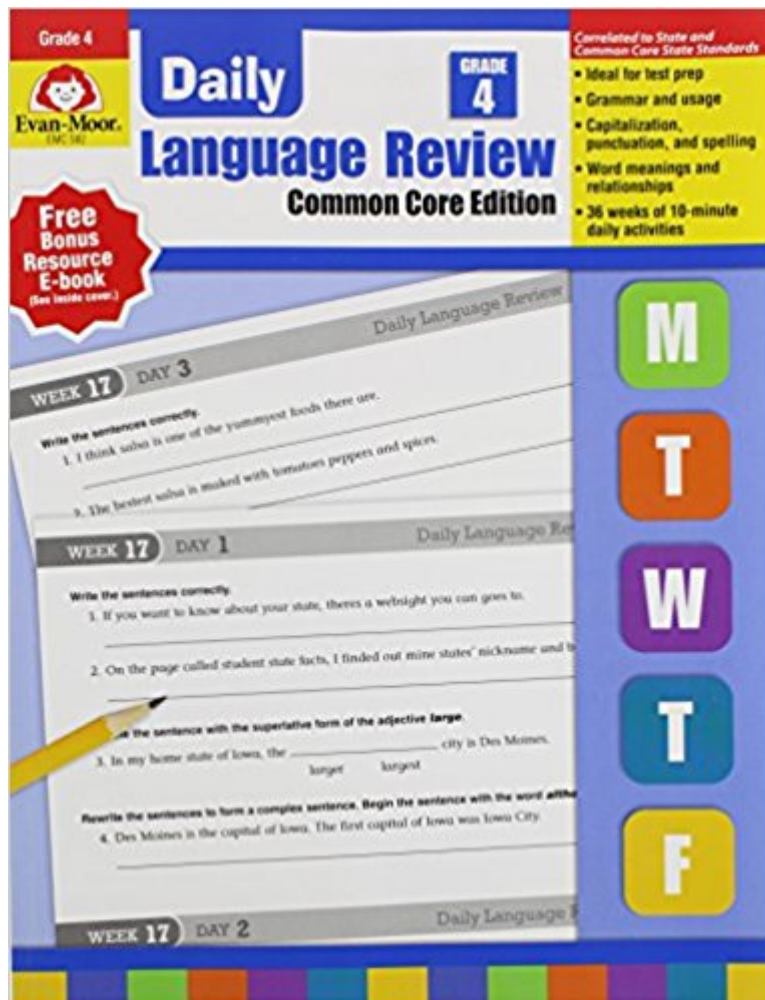

While this is not exactly a "grammar" book, it is well thought out. The book does not give five pages of adjective exercises, then five pages of adverb exercises, etc., like many text and workbooks. The student studies / corrects entire sentences at a time. It means that the student has a reason to remember the rules, because he is using them in context. We do not use this brand only as a review. We use them, with a little extra explanation, in everyday schooling. All our children love the variety, and the fact that the concepts are joined and mixed in everyday sentences. In short, the

book provides more opportunities for using the principles studied, rather than just fill-in-the-blank scenarios, which are quickly forgotten. If you as a parent / caregiver are not sure about grammatical principles yourself, this will not be the book to use by itself. However, with a few printouts / clarifications off the internet, it can be used by anyone.

This book has 36 weeks of daily warm ups. Each day has a different set up, so the students will not get bored with them. However, every day there is at least one sentence to be corrected. I plan on using this in my classroom as daily warm ups, and the students will do one a day in a warm up notebook. This book also comes with a free e-book. The free e-book has the skills for each of the warm ups for this book, as well as activities that can be used in small groups or stations. I would definitely recommend this for any 4th grade ELA teacher or parent!

My child's fourth grade teacher uses this in her curriculum. Since my son struggles with rules of grammar and spelling, this book gives him additional practice to strengthen his learning. I only wish it had a slightly lower price tag. But as far as "home" tutoring goes, the price tag is worth it and I highly recommend this purchase!

I teach 7th grade intensive students using Springboard materials and this was a nice supplement for activities or homework to have them practice their revision and part of speech activities. It is a bit of a challenge since they don't use the skills daily, but after only a few weeks, they are improving on this and in their writing!

Used daily as a warm up for writing and editing, this book helped keep language rules and concepts in the fore front of my students' short term memory while eventually going into long term memory. They worked in cooperative groups to complete the 5-10 minute work time I allowed. This was

followed by a whole class activity to go over responses for correction. Excellent book!

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
