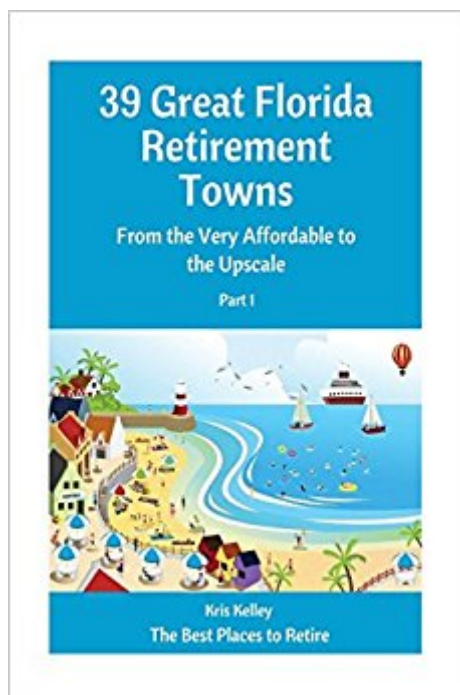


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39 Great Florida Retirement Towns: From The Very Affordable To The Upscale (The Best Places To Retire) (Volume 3)

This book breaks down the towns by affluence (those with a cost of living above the national average, and those below). It offers consistent information about each town, such as whether there's an accredited hospital, a library and public transit (and more), and crime rates, political leanings, and such, and even presents any drawbacks (e.g. heavy traffic during annual events) alongside the positives. Sure, one could gather by researching oneself - but Ms. Kelley has already done all the leg work, and it's done well. I found it very helpful.
