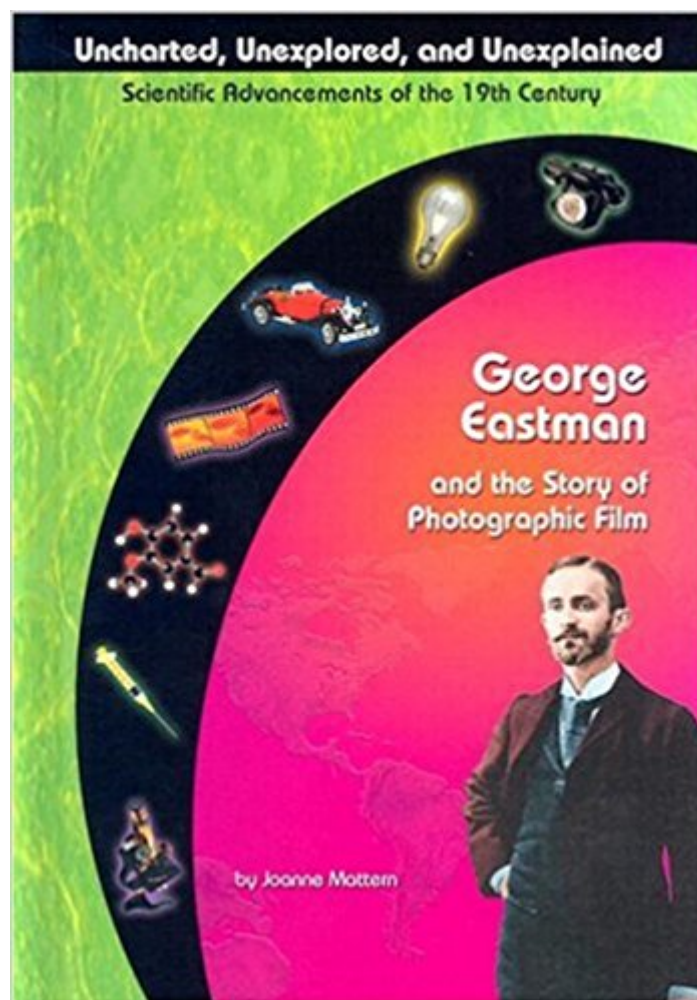


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George Eastman And Photographic Film (Uncharted, Unexplored, And Unexplained: Scientific Advancements Of The 19th Century)
