

I ordered a used copy that was a 1997 edition. Not sure what the situation is with newer ones, but this is still an excellent guide to Javanese culture, with much deeper detail than other books.

Goes in depth about culture. The author includes many side trips and small villages that are worth a visit.

This book contains excellent background information on Java and descriptions of both its major highlights and obscure attractions - particularly archeological remains and national parks - written by a team of expert authors along with photos of stunning quality. Practical information is found separately in the back of the book, and is somewhat dated but still adequate. Highly recommended, even as a 2nd guidebook if you already have a general Indonesia guide stronger on practical details like Lonely Planet or Rough Guide.
