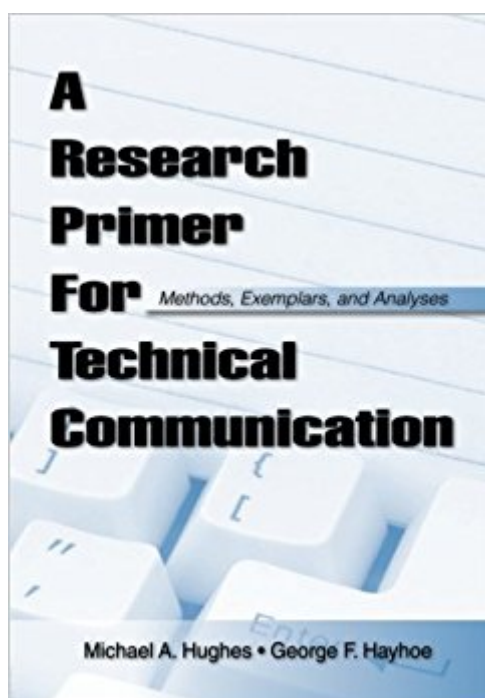

Overall, this has some really good information, but can tend to be a bit long-winded. I bought this for a class I'm taking, and I can't say I would have bought it otherwise. It is nicely broken up into chapters and sections with clear headings. However, page numbers are different on the e-book so

it's sometimes hard to find exactly what I need when my professor only gives a page number. It is definitely well written, and helpful for defining and explaining research methods too.

I read this book as part of the reading for a Master's course. I found it to be very informative with solid examples. It is also well-structured.

I bought this book for a thesis writing class as a Technical Communications major. It is a fairly good resource for how to assemble and write a thorough research paper/thesis. However, coming from a very scientific background, much of the information was redundant and basic, such as how to evaluate statistical significance. Overall, though, it was well spent money (and was required reading for the class) and will remain on my shelf as a resource book for future papers.
