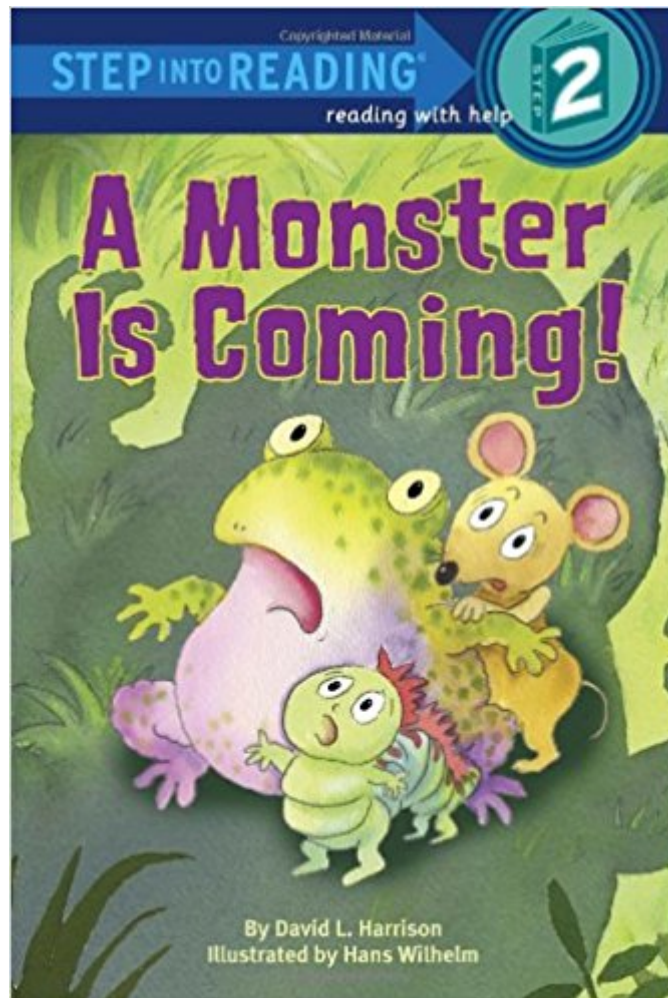

She is a little behind in reading, so I purchased several books in several levels and different difficulties trying to catch her up. This book is a mid-difficulty level 2. It is challenging but not as hard to read as some of the level 2's I bought. It is about monsters and all kids fear yet are drawn to monster stories. It is very cutely written and will definately draw a child into the story. My granddaughter loves it and so do her younger siblings. There are a lot of challenging words to try and will work well to get her to "reach" for the reading and understanding of the words.

I wanted to buy a book for a kindergarten child who is learning to read and found David L. Harrison's Step-Into-Reading book, A Monster Is Coming. The storyline is simple but funny, and the color illustrations are so cute! The little boy really enjoyed it. This was a great choice.
