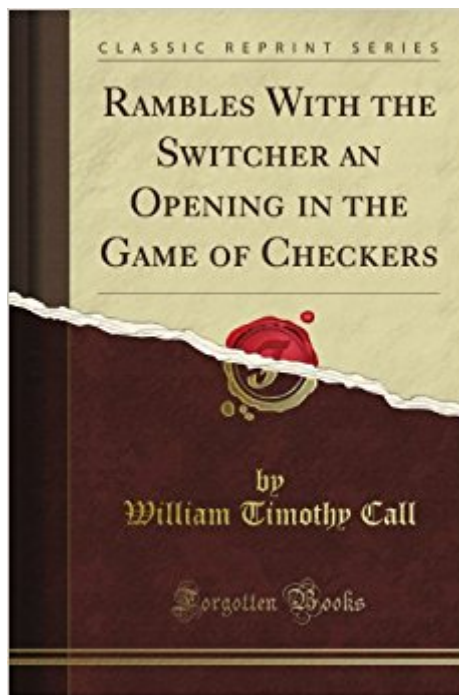




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Rambles With The Switcher An Opening In The Game Of Checkers (Classic Reprint)



Synopsis
