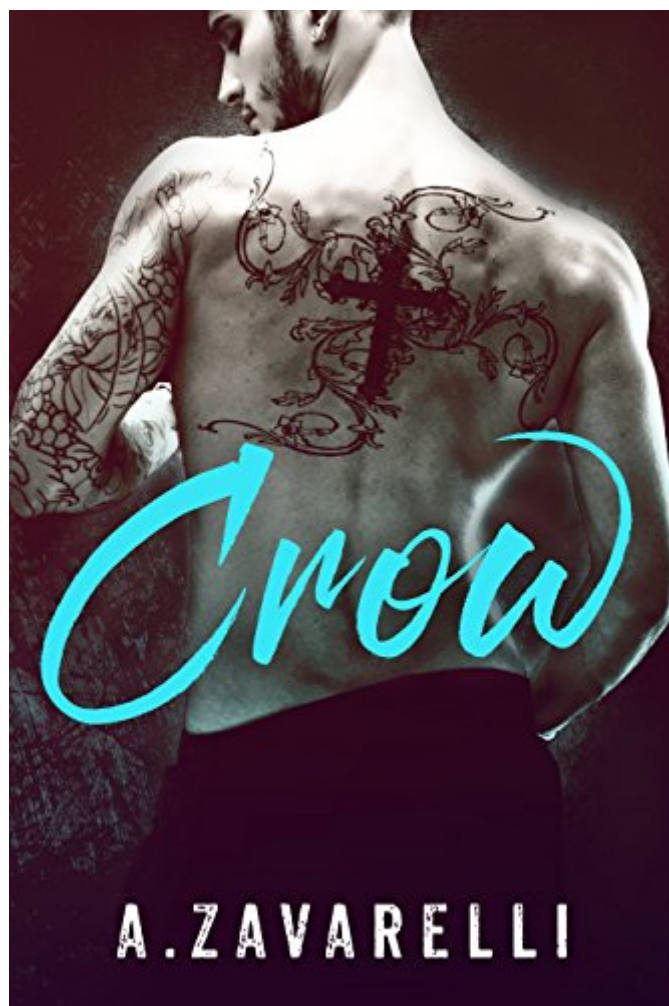

I loved Zavarelli's writing style and the great character development between the two very different leads. Crow follows Mack, who is on the search for her missing friend. When the police and PI can't help her, she decides to take the task into her own hands. Meaning risking her life too infiltrate the Irish mafia. Mack catches the eye of one of the leaders, Lachlan, who is mean and hard-core to the bone. Mack doesn't know what she's in for when she starts working in this new world, but she'll do anything to find her friend. Even more of a surprise, is that she's not prepared to fall for Lachlan, whom she doesn't even know if she can trust. But with everyone having secrets, there is no way to tell who is telling the truth and who is going to stab someone in the back. Mack is the definition of a "bad-ass woman" she is a fighter, like her father was. But also she doesn't back down when face with the possibly she's going to die.
