

I felt the information wasn't presented in the most logical order. I also really liked some restaurants (that weren't super new) that were not mentioned, and felt the itineraries were not what I was looking for. We just did Banff, Icefields Parkway, and Canmore thought, maybe it is better for people doing all three parks. I was surprised I couldn't find information about Ha Ling, a popular and tough climb in Canmore. I like how Moon books give you a hint as to what is a favorite.

Helped us figure out the key things we should do, weather permitting. Current issue as well. Usual Lonely Planet dependability. However, the restaurant section and hotel sections were a bit limited, but that seems to be true of many of the Lonely Planet guides. Other travel guides may be more comprehensive in this area.

This is a fantastic book if you're planning a trip to any of these parks! I went to Glacier without this book, and wish I had it. I bought this book because I'm planning a trip to Banff next. It's small, so perfect for travelling, but it still packs a ton of information. It was everything from lodging/camping and their prices, food and where to find it, hikes and their difficulty/length/altitude, to maps of the entire park and where you should go for specific activities, rentals, or to see particular wildlife. I can't wait to put this book to use in Banff next year! Would highly recommend.
