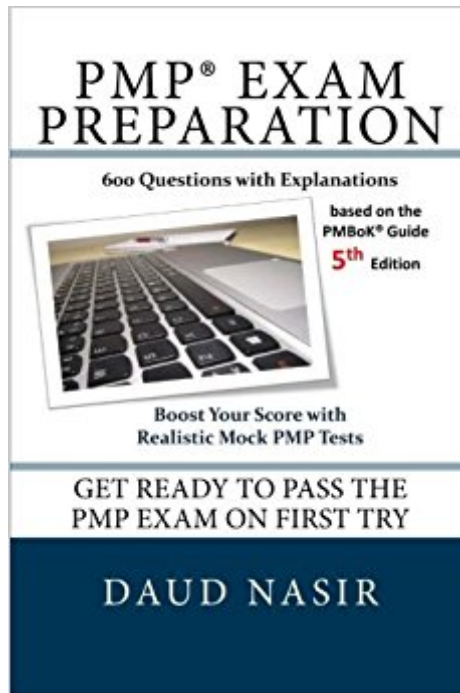

Just went through the first set of questions... the author has an extremely poor English and writes his sentences in a VERY unusual way, I had to read each question several times just to understand what the hell is he saying. The whole text in this book looks like was written in a foreign language and then ran through Google Translate program... I have also found at least one question when the author seems to get confused himself with math estimating the number communication channels and did not provide correct option for an answer (q-n 154): Project manager has 6 people on his team (the way I see it is 6+ project manager =7), then the number increased to 11, how many

communication channels were added? He derives his math from a team of 6 and then of 11... I have used various books to prepare for this exams, they all warn about this kind of questions as a trick question.. PM had X number of people in her team which implies $X+1$... looks like Mr. Nasir got tricked himself.. but the worst part really is the language the book is written in.

You know, this book is strange. There are many grammar mistakes in the questions. Some questions (very few, less than 1%) are arguably answers that could be wrong if you think about PM processes the way PMI tells you to. However, it's hard to argue with results. After a lot of studying through Rita, it's only through studying this book that I was able to get a handle on the many tricks required to pass the exam. I scored all "Proficient" on the 5 knowledge areas, so I am vrey happy with the result, and thus recommend this book to anybody who wants a cost-effective way to train for the PMP. "Cost-effective", in the sense that for the price, you get a lot of questions that help effectively prepare for the PMP.

With the help of this book I passed the PMP exam first time. The questions are excellent - very representative of the questions on the actual PMP exam I took. The answer explanations really help you to understands process areas you may be struggling to grasp. If you read the PMBOK, understand all the processes and their ITTOs, and take the tests in this book you should be well prepared.

Bought this book as a supplement to Rita Mulcahy's PMP study guide. This book was great for testing my knowledge and seeing where I needed to study more. I found that the questions on the real exam were not structured the same. This book concentrates on asking questions like which of the following are INCORRECT etc. In addition, the book is filled with grammatical errors and it was difficult to understand what was being asked on a few questions. Otherwise the book did its job in helping me identify where I was lacking in knowledge.

Great book. It gives you plenty of practice so when you get to the exam you know what to expect, and you are not nervous because you have done it all before. Also, not only does it tell you why the right answer is right, but it also tells you why the wrong answers are wrong.

Improved, actually not so much because of references to 5th edition of PMBOK, but more because of navigation, which did not exist before. With previous version, I had to work around by having two

Kindles open at the same time, one in Questions area, and the other in Answers area. That obvious obstacle was alleviated in this edition. With every question, you have a "Check Answer" link, which, in turn, has a "Back to Question" link. Answer still explain both the correct and the wrong options. And, if one cannot remember the question they just answered, well, that is a short term memory problem. So, improved and much less time consuming. Good drill. As for that "discount" sales pitch offer (in the intro of the book) for additional tests which can be downloaded from a web site, with additional charges.... Three tests are more than enough for anybody to test the mettle. No need to bother with more.

I took and passed the PMP on my first attempt. I used this book as my primary source of practice questions in preparing for the PMP exam so let me start by saying it served its purposes. With that said I have some serious issues with the book and wouldn't strongly recommend it to others. I would say about 10% of the questions in each 200 question practice exams were out of left field and were not indicative of the PMP exam. Many of those same questions and a few others had very general answers that I couldn't tie back to the PMBOK. It would have been very helpful if the answer to each questions also cited a page or section of the PMBOK you could refer to for more information.

Questions are close to the real exam. The quality of questions is good enough to be used as a supplement for PMP exam preparation. However, on real exam, there is not so many one-liner questions as seen on this book. Most of the questions are situational in nature and don't often ask for direct memorization of PMBOK as some of the questions on this book. Recommended as the book is reasonable priced with good enough questions. It had helped me pass the exam.
