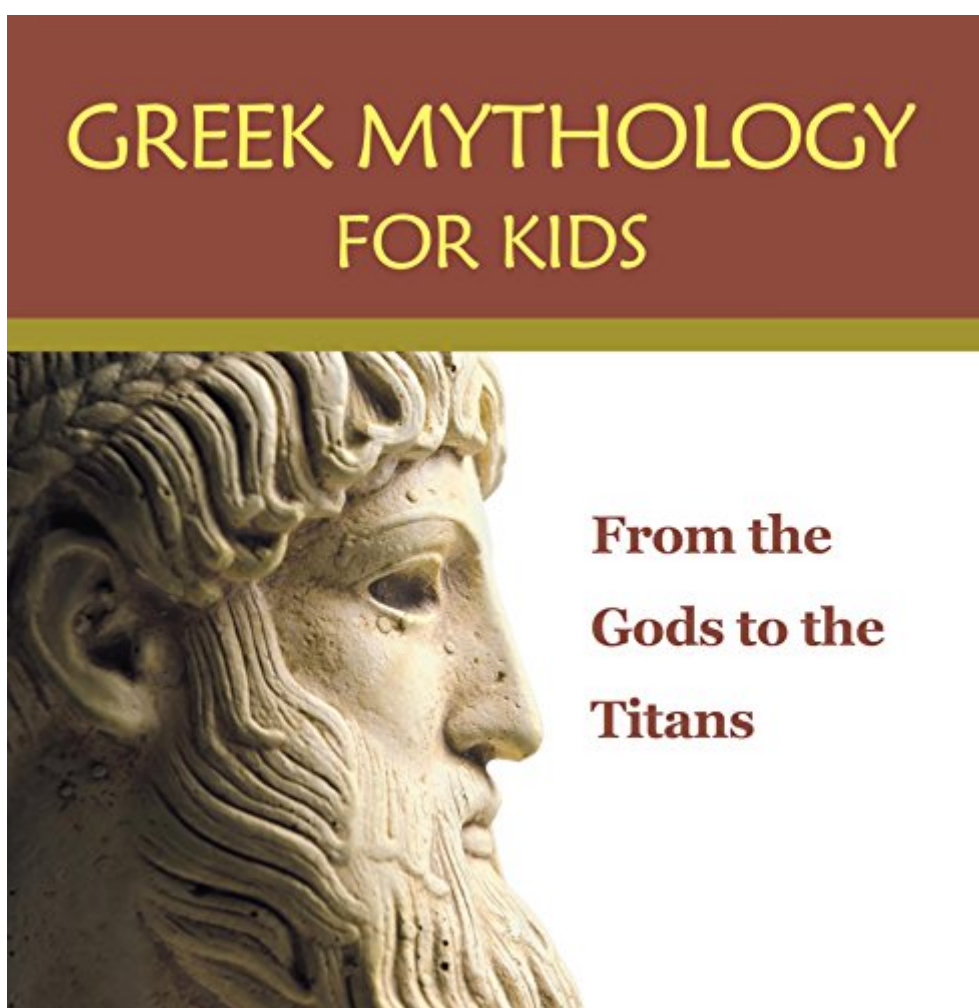

I first like you to know that I usually purchase e book samples before purchasing a book . I have purchased books in the past and was highly disappointed. especially when it comes to childrens books. This one was a disappointment and I will not be purchasing it in paperback form. First I would like to say the pictures were of the greek statues they were nice. The 1 or 2 sentences that they did say were a real disappointment. Ex. Zeus was the king of the greek gods, His famous power was to throw lightning balls. I was so upset with this book. I was really hoping it would be a actual story from the greek myths. I would pass on this book but you may like it. If you can download it yourself I would so you can see for yourself it may be exactly what you are looking for. BUt I will say it is not for small children they would get bored. And the older ones would be like ok I knew that.

It just isn't a keeper in my book. I hope you can find the right book for your kids as I to will keep on the search.

There is a photo of a statue of each Greek god or goddess and a column of text on each page. The overall book design is clean and uncluttered. The language is easy to understand. There is no story presented with any real flow to the content. Instead, the book reads like a set of flashcards. As a result, the book serves as an introduction for each god or goddess. I thought the facts presented in Greek Mythology for Kids: From the Gods to the Titans were helpful, but the book had a few problems worth mentioning. In the single introductory statement, the author indicates that there are twelve Olympians but only identifies ten in the book. Without providing any transition, the author names four Titans. Further, although either "Titans" or "Titanes" is correct, the author should have selected one option for consistency instead of using both terms. All of the photos are good quality; however, the photo of the Apollo statue is cut off at the neckline, resulting in a nude, headless image that oddly stands out in the book. I wondered why the author did not select a better photo. The oversight diminished the overall quality seen in the rest of the book. I think the book would have been more helpful with a coherent introduction, transition point and ending. Disclaimer: I received this Kindle book for free in exchange for an honest review.

I was given this book for free for my honest review. I feel that this is a great stepping stone book to get the spark of interest going. My 8 year old son got more interest out of the book than my 5 year old son did. Now my 8 year old wants me to find more books on greek mythology. All the pictures in this book are of statues. They are nice pictures and have a way of bringing myth into more of a reality. In one of the pictures they cropped the head off unnecessarily, and the Aphrodite picture is of an angel not of her. It is a short book and a quick read and I loved that it prompted my kids to ask questions, unfortunately the answer were not in this book and luckily greek mythology is a passion of mine.

Based on the description of this book I expected much more than what I got. My son and I were excited to find this free ebook as he is very interested in Greek and Norse mythology. He was excited to learn more about characters he had learned a little about both in school and in the comic book world. What we got was a short, lackluster description of some of the greek pantheon. The book is 18 pages, each page has a short paragraph and a visual of the god or goddess being described, most in the form of statues. The photo's were great, the descriptions were short and

lacking any real substance. The book might hold the interest of a very young child, but my 10 year old and I both found it boring.

OK, let me start off with, I was able to get this item at a discounted rate for exchange a fair and honest review. OK now for the honest review! This Kindle book is a print replica and is not intended to be used as an interactive application. Lots of great picture! Crisp, clean, clear photos. This is a very good picture book. good for small children. If you want fun and interesting facts, look elsewhere. All the picture of the gods, are just statues, and some they cropped the heads out of the picture. No illustrations or painting, just statues. The sad part is, it's a cookie cutter book, all the books in this series are all the same format. Nothing really awesome. 18 pages of facts and pictures. This is a quick now go to bed book!
