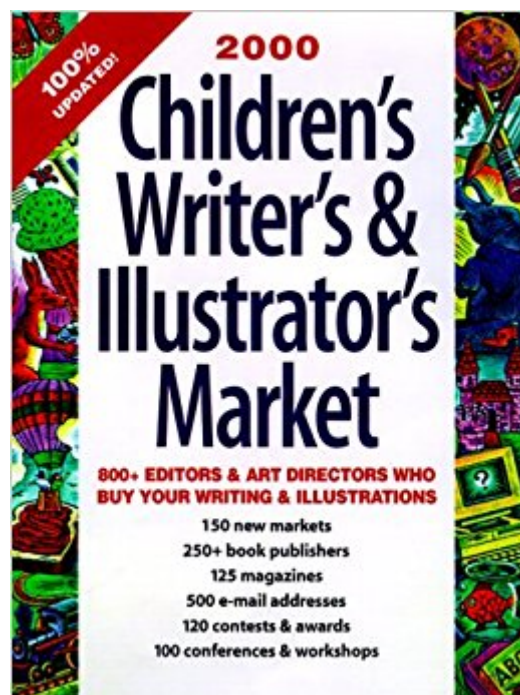

If you want to find out where to submit your novel or story, there's no doubt that Children's Writer's & Illustrator's Market is about the best place to look. Unfortunately, despite the 2000 edition's claim of containing 250+ book publishers, the number I found suitable for a fantasy novel was pathetically small. A publisher for children that doesn't have a fantasy list has always seemed to me like a butcher shop without sausages, a hot bread shop without French loaves, a sweet shop without toffees ...However, this is a publishing fault rather than a criticism of the book. My only criticism of the book itself is that you have to shelve out somewhere in the region of US\$22 every year. Using last year's edition could land you up addressing your package to the wrong editor.

This book to find publisher's and agents was published in the year 2000. Most of the information is totally outdated. Save your money.

Writer's Market not only emphasizes markets for children's authors and publishers in many different areas, but presents wonderful articles on how to approach editors and art departments.
